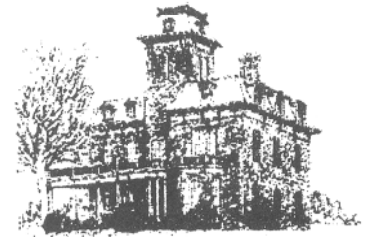

**Dear Friend;**

**Your financial support is needed to preserve Glenmore Mansion in Jefferson City.** This 131 year old building has been damaged by the weather over the years.

I'm Helen Gray, president of the local APTA chapter. Before asking the community for help, our members raised as much money as possible in other ways. Special events held at Glenmore over the last five years have raised \$33,000. Also, grants were recently received from the Tennessee Historical Society and the state APTA. This money allowed us to get started. An outside contractor has replaced most of the gutters, downspouts and crown facia. **At this time, \$96,000 is needed to restore damaged windows and brickwork, finish the guttering, and add a copper roof to cover an area where temporary repairs were made.** Damage to ceilings and interior walls has been repaired by volunteers.

Glenmore is listed in the National Register For Historic Places. The Civil War battle of Mossy Creek was fought on this site and the mansion was built shortly thereafter. It is a major tourist attraction. During the past 18 months, thousands of people from 27 states and many foreign countries have visited. Several photos of the building are enclosed.
